*Responsibilities of Senior Vice Chancellor

The Senior Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs at the University of California, San Diego, is the chief academic officer of the University, responsible for policies and decisions relating to

instruction, academic programs and curriculum, and faculty appointments and performance. The Senior Vice Chancellor is also the University's chief operating officer, the institution's second-ranking executive officer, and acts on behalf of the Chancellor in overseeing the University in his absence. The chief academic officer provides intellectual and academic leadership to the campus, and assures that UCSD maintains the highest academic standards in teaching, research, and public service. In that role, the Senior Vice Chancellor supervises the recruitment, advancement, and retention of all faculty, deans, and other academic leaders; and oversees academic planning, programs, and budgeting. The Senior Vice Chancellor is responsible for graduate, undergraduate, and professional education, the colleges, research centers, the UCSD library, and the Super Computer.
